Good Shepherd Sunday—25th April 2021

We welcome Nicholas Calandra, a 2nd Year seminarian from Corpus Christi College, Carlton who will address us this weekend about his vocational journey. He comments "Despite being taken to Mass every Sunday; as a kid I didn't know much about the Catholic faith. I rarely thought of God and was not keen to go to Mass. This all changed when I was a young teenager. I started learning about the truths of our faith. The reality of sin, the mercy of God and our need for confession / reconciliation which is the way Christ washes away our sins and sets us back on the road to heaven. I learned that the Eucharist is not a symbol; but actually becomes Our Lord Himself, really and substantially present after the moment of consecration!
