New QR Registration System

At St Peter's Clayton, we are using a QR System for registration to enter the church for all Masses. To assist, you may wish to download the **Service Victoria app**.

Once you have scanned the QR code using the app at the doors of the church, please proceed to the glass doors (closest to the toilets) and show the usher your green tick confirming your registration. You will need to register for each individual in your group and show the usher the green tick after each registration.

Stations of the Cross—will be held in the Church at 7:00pm every Friday during Lent. This could be an act of prayer for your Lenten discipline. Doors will open at 6:30pm and close 6:50pm (10 mins) before the Stations.

Ushers needed—for both the 6:00pm (vigil) and 11:00am Mass on Sundays, especially those who can speak Italian. We require at least 5 people per mass otherwise masses will be cancelled purely due to the lack of ushers. Ushers please sign up on sheets provided in the narthex.

No mass bookings are required, however we have a maximum capacity for 220 people due to COVID restrictions. All people must register with the QR code provided at the church doors. Doors open 40 minutes before the beginning of mass and close 10 minutes before mass begins to ensure our COVID Safe plan is actioned.
