Attendance for the Triduum and Easter Services

The Triduum and Easter services must be celebrated in a COVID safe way. Therefore **you must book in for the Triduum Services** as this allows for the monitoring of numbers (max. 220ppl). Bookings can be made online through the parish website or if you need assistance please contact the parish office on 9544 1516 (Monday, Thursday or Friday 10:00am—4:00pm). When you arrive, confirm with the usher that you are booked in and register using the QR code for contact tracing.

We need your assistance for this COVID safe plan and require a number of ushers. Please sign up in the narthex on the sheets provided.

Memorial Wall for the Interment of Ashes—The St Peter's Clayton Memorial Wall is especially for parishioners who wish to have theirs or loved ones ashes interred OR theirs or loved ones names placed on a remembrance plaque. Please contact the parish office.

Stations of the Cross—will be held in the Church at 7:00pm every Friday during Lent. This could be an act of prayer for your Lenten discipline. Doors will open at 6:30pm and close 6:50pm (10 mins) before the stations.

It's now time to come home to Mass—No mass bookings are required, except for the Triduum and Easter Services. However we have a maximum capacity for 220 people due to COVID restrictions. All people must register with the QR code provided at the church doors. Doors open 40 minutes before the beginning of mass and close 10 minutes before mass begins to ensure our COVID Safe plan is actioned.
